



Group Service Representatives (GSRs)

act as liaison between their meeting and ANCoR Intergroup, providing information in **both** directions. The reference document links to the right are particularly helpful tools for GSRs and all members of the fellowship.

GSRs are chosen by their meeting group via an informed group conscience (gc) of the group they represent. Each GSR (and preferably an alternate) is selected by any method deemed appropriate by their group.

Healthy meetings rotate volunteers in various meeting service roles, including GSRs. Their term is usually 1-2 years, but is also determined by group conscience of each independent meeting.
